You are familiar with the institutions and decision making processes in Croatia and the EU. You speak English and Croatian fluently. Greenpeace in Central and Eastern Europe (CEE) with the headquarters in Vienna is looking for a Campaigner to work in its office in Croatia. Main responsibilities include planning and implementation of Greenpeace campaigns in the field of energy and climate change, as well as other fields within the scope of Greenpeace work such as fisheries and agriculture. Most work will be done in close cooperation with the Team Leader and other Greenpeace staff, domestic and international, and involve interaction with relevant leaders, opinion makers and other green NGOs.

Main responsibilities

Planning of campaigns

- Research to get basics for the development of campaign projects and pushes
- Together with media and action staff, define campaign goals, strategy and tactics
- Develop campaign proposals and plans, including budget proposal

Implementation of campaigns

- Integration and coordination of internal staff involved, as well as external if required
- Content-controlling and adjustment of ongoing campaigns
- Public speaker's function as needed, in coordination with media officer
- Lobbying (politics, economy, NGO scene, participation in working groups)
- Prepare lobbying talking points
- Prepare and update content for new media channels

Ongoing campaign work

- Reply to high level inquiries
- High level talks/lectures
- Read relevant Greenpeace mailing lists
- Keep an overview of external events (conferences, political meetings, etc.)
- Keep contact and information flow with team leader, and other Greenpeace offices

- Fluency in Croatian and English
- Basic computer skills (Word, Excel, web)
- Knowledge of Croatian and EU institutions, and decision-making processes
- Strong knowledge of environmental issues and interactions among politics, economy and society
- Basic knowledge of economics

- Very good argumentation and negotiation skills

- Professional or volunteer NGO experience is an asset
